

SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT FOR ZEBRA TECHNOLOGIES CORPORATION BENEFLEX PLAN

This is a summary of the annual report of the Zebra Technologies Corporation Beneflex Plan (Employer Identification Number 36-2675536, Plan Number 501) for the plan year 01/01/2024 through 12/31/2024. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Zebra Technologies Corporation has committed itself to pay certain medical, dental and temporary disability claims incurred under the terms of the plan.

Insurance Information

The plan has insurance contracts with Lincoln National Life Insurance Company, Kaiser Foundation Health Plan, Inc., EyeMed Vision Care on Behalf of Fidelity Security Life Insurance Co., Massachusetts Mutual Life Insurance Company, Federal Insurance Company, Cigna Health and Life Insurance Company, Provident Life and Accident Insurance Company, Provident Life and Casualty Insurance Company, The Lincoln National Life Insurance Company and EyeMed Vision Care on behalf of Fidelity Security Life Insurance Co. to pay certain life, accidental death and dismemberment, medical, vision, long-term disability, business travel accident, critical illness, accident and employee assistance program claims incurred under the terms of the plan. The total premiums paid for the plan year ending 12/31/2024 were \$8,575,069.
